



EQUIPPING HUDDLE // LEADER GUIDE

Sharing a More Irresistible Faith - Part 2 | EASTSIDE CHRISTIAN CHURCH

This huddle is a walk through Andy Stanley's book *Irresistible* in four sessions. Each session is based on one of the four parts in the book. Have participants watch this [video of Andy](#) to get an idea of what it's all about.

Part 2 (Chapters 6 through 13)

1. Who gave you your first Bible? What did they say it was? What did you believe it was? How has that influenced your spiritual journey?
2. Andy says that bad church experiences are almost always rooted in remnants of the Old Covenant. Do you agree or disagree? Give a specific example?
3. Andy cites three imports from the Old Covenant that have infected the church: self righteousness, legalism, and the prosperity gospel. I would add the "us/them" dichotomy. Can you trace their roots in the Old Testament? Have they ever affected you personally?
4. Could someone justify discrimination based on the Old Testament? How about the Sermon on the Mount? Be specific.
5. How could this statement from Andy be true: *"The Bible is all God's Word to somebody. It's just not all God's word to everybody"*?
6. Read Matthew 28:16-20. What commands do you think Jesus was referring to? What does this mean in light of our *Irresistible* discussion?

7. Read Acts 15:1-35. What are the guiding principles that Jesus' brother is using to create policy for the movement here? What can you learn from this as a church leader?

8. Jesus said he came to fulfill the law (see Matthew 5:17-20.) What does that mean to you? How does that connect with Andy's illustration of a new iPhone?
