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## FAMILY DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

All of us have been given gifts, and each gift is just as important as the others.

**Gifts and talents can be things like:**

Caring for others, Listener, Encourager, Helper, Teacher, Giver, Artist, Writer, Athletic, etc...

**Have everyone go around and share what gifts and talents they see in each person.**

Take time to affirm what you see in each other. Remind younger family members that many people don't know some of their gifts and talents until they grow older.

**Luisa has incredible strength, and most people might think she's always fine. But under the surface she felt pressure and felt like a lot of people had expectations for her that made her feel overwhelmed. She feels like she has to be strong for her whole family all of the time. She doesn't want to let anyone down.**

Have you ever felt like Luisa?

**Bruno had a gift that sometimes told people things they didn't want to hear about their future. Because people didn't want to hear bad things, they made him feel isolated and unwanted.**

Have you ever felt left out or unwanted?

**Isabel feels like she has to be perfect all of the time, and she doesn't feel free to be real.**

Do you ever feel like you have to be perfect all of the time? How does that make you feel?

**Everyone can help others even if it's not their gift; they just have to be willing to try and help. The whole neighborhood worked together to rebuild Casita, and they all made a difference!**
