ASSIGNMENT 1

Colossians 3:12-17

So, as those who have been chosen of God, holy and beloved, put on a heart of compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience; bearing with one another, and forgiving each other, whoever has a complaint against anyone; just as the Lord forgave you, so also should you. Beyond all these things put on love, which is the perfect bond of unity. Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body; and be thankful. Let the word of Christ richly dwell within you, with all wisdom teaching and admonishing one another with psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with thankfulness in your hearts to God. Whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks through Him to God the Father.

QUESTIONS:

1. *What character qualities do the chosen of God (those who have a personal relationship with Christ) have?*
2. *Of those qualities, what is the one that is the perfect bond of unity?*
3. *What should rule in our hearts? What should dwell richly within us?*
4. *In all things that we do or say, what do we need to do? What does that mean for our daily lives?*

ASSIGNMENT 2

Read [Chapter 1](#), The First Fred, of *The Fred Factor* by Mark Sanborn.

Fred is a living example of the power of being an extraordinary leader in ordinary moments. Everything he does, he does to the best of his ability, and above and beyond what his “job description” would entail.

QUESTIONS:

1. *Have you ever met a “Fred” before? What stood out to you about that “Fred”?*
2. *How did it make you feel after interacting with that “Fred”?*
3. *How was Fred intentional?*

ASSIGNMENT 3

Read [Chapter 2](#), The Fred Principles, of *The Fred Factor* by Mark Sanborn. Let's explore the four Fred Principles from this chapter.

QUESTIONS:

1. *Principle #1: Everyone Makes A Difference. In the book, Mark talks about how everyone can make a difference.*
 - *What kind of difference do you make at home?*
 - *What kind of difference do you make at work?*

- *What kind of difference do you make in your area of ministry in Kidside?*

2. *Principle #2: Success Is Built On Relationships. In a world where more and more of our interaction with others is through social media, online, and automated responses, it's increasingly difficult to build true relationships.*

- *How have negative relationships with others impacted you in the past?
Present?*

- *How have positive relationships with others impacted you in the past?
Present?*

- *How can you create and build positive relationships with others at your home, work, and area of service at Kidside?*

3. *Principle #3: You Must Continually Create Value For Others, and It Doesn't Have To Cost A Penny.*

- *How are you competing with your own potential in all areas of your life and service?*

- *How can you creatively create value without spending a penny at home? At work? In Kidside?*

4. *Principle #4: You Can Reinvent Yourself Regularly.*

- *How can you reinvent yourself?*

Read [Chapter 4](#), Everyone Makes a Difference, of *The Fred Factor* by Mark Sanborn.

QUESTIONS:
