6:45 – 6:50 | Icebreaker – “BOLD OR BAD IDEA?”

“Alright, let's loosen up with a quick game called ‘Bold or Bad Idea?’ – because tonight we're talking about bold moves, and I want to see who in here actually lives like that... or who plays it a little too safe. 😊

Here's how it works:

I'll throw out a situation, and your table decides if it's a BOLD move or a BAD idea.

You're going to face your group and when I am done you're going to throw up a 'thumbs up' for a BOLD move or a 'thumbs down' for a bad idea.

Then one person with a thumbs up and one person with a thumbs down will share one short reason for their choice. Let's have some fun!”

Here’s the thing – some bold moves *really are* bad ideas... but other times, boldness is exactly what God uses to build something new.

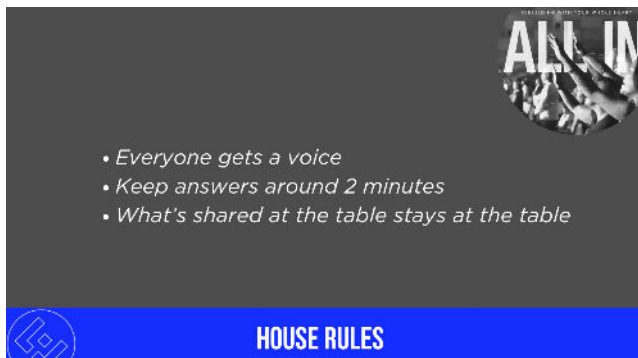

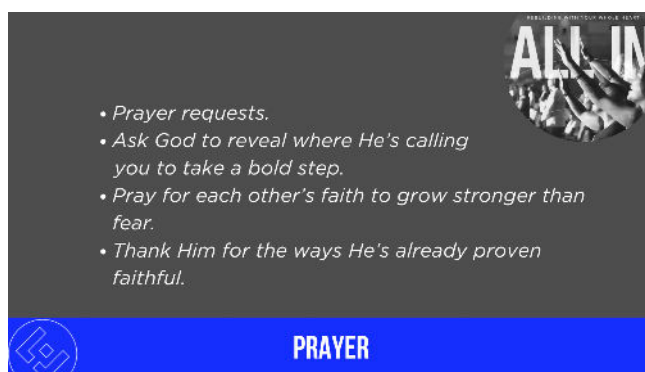

Last Thursday we had several people from different campuses logging in and we listened to 5 chapters! If you've wanted to be in God's Word more, this is a great way to do it.

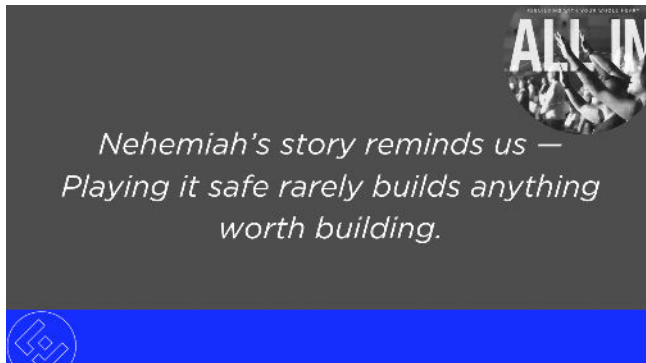
