Here’s how it works: I’ll throw out a few prompts and you can pick one to share with your table. Be honest, be funny, keep it short – bonus points if you can make your table laugh out loud.”

Prompts (should this be a slide?):

- 1 Describe a DIY project that should’ve been a team project. How’d that go?
- 2 What's the funniest group project fail you've ever been part of?
- 3 Ever try to volunteer for one thing at church and get roped into something totally different? Tell us the story!

(Give 3–4 minutes for sharing. Walk around, laugh with tables.)

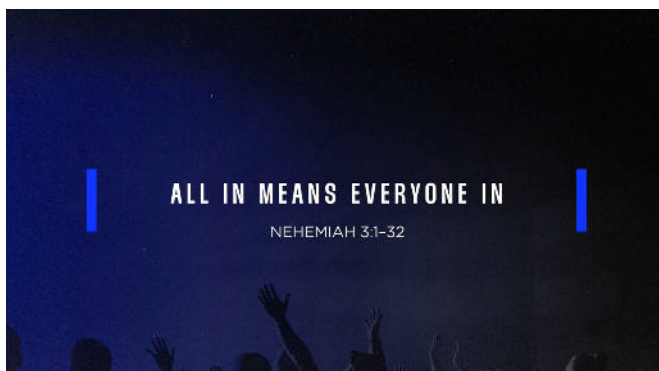
SLIDE 3 – Teaching Intro





HOST:

(Invite leader to stand or say a sentence about their group.)

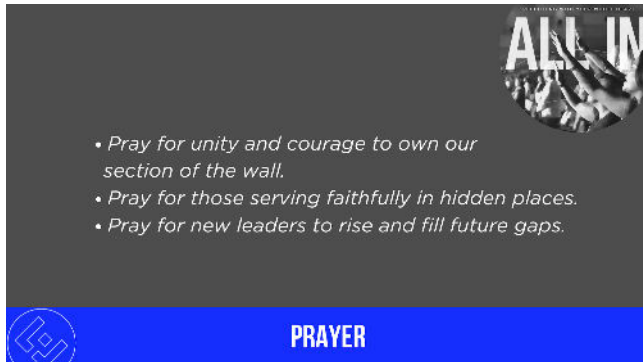
HOST TRANSITION:
